Communities of Digitization: A Definition



- Cultural Heritage Institutions of all types (libraries, museums, historical societies, archives, records centers, etc.) working together on a local or regional digital initiative.
- Institutions working together on a project and utilizing each others' strengths

Communities of Digitization: Some Models



- Museum has objects and interpretive information on townspeople
- Historical Society has their letters, manuscripts
- Archives has Sanborn maps, etc.
- Library has scanning equipment, catalogers
